If you intend to purchase and/or apply restricted use pesticides for the purpose of producing an agricultural commodity on land which is owned or rented by you, then you need a Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture Pesticide License. To become a certified private applicator, testing is required. This full day session on January 29 will cover the basics and prepare you for the pesticide applicator's exam which will take place the next morning, January 30, from 8:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.
